

Elephant Head

Stout
5.9

Lovely grassy picnic ledge. A third pitch finish is possible, though reportedly not great.

One full length rappel (~180') off of pinches in blocks (extra webbing to leave could be good)

Up arete to blocky but solid finish

Though dirty, the features + style of climbing + exposure on this beyond plumb crack system make it memorable. A stiff 5.9! Bring big gear (4/5/6) and ≥14 draws. Probably takes a while to dry after rain.

Step left into flake
3/4 works

Big ledge. Climbing easy

Crux. Right at top before pulling crux x #4 fits pretty well

Bolt line/trad heads right (?)

Mossy crack

Slung Flake (bringing some leaver (tad) not a bad idea.

6" ledge

Dirty, loose pocket - have belayer on loose enough anchor to move right when necessary

P1 ~80'

2 bolt anchor!

Start left of crack, then move into it

Elephant Head Gully Ice Route

"Watch for Falling Rocks"

Gully path

~100'
