

LA MALINCHE (14,435' / 4811m)

(The Aztec Bride of Cortez)

Sendero to A Subsidiary Peak

Prominent Rock Fin

Steep drop-off with views into the dormant crater

10-20' of 3rd class scrambling to Al Cima de Malinche

Talus slope

SENDERO meets the Ridge Approximately a 13,800'

Grande Piedra

Tree line + large open, sandy incline toward the ridge.

Sendero plateaus at 12,000'

Sendero Dificil (20°+ incline)

CARRETERA Continuar

Aviso para "La Cima" Approximately a 11,000'

AUTO ROAD Goes up to ~11,000' (NO TRAFFIC). Footpath cuts through offering a more direct route.

This climb covers approximately 4.5 miles and 4,000' (1333m). There are some steep sections and some sections with loose rock. Unless there has been recent precipitation, snow cover is likely to be minimal.
